1 Introduction

- 1.1 Transform Scotland is the national alliance for sustainable transport, bringing together organisations from the private, public and voluntary sectors. Transform Scotland's vision is for a transport system that is environmentally sustainable, socially inclusive and economically responsible.
- 1.2 Transform Scotland has been awarded funding through the Scottish Government's Enterprise Ready Fund to set up the 'transform research and communications' social enterprise. This new enterprise will offer contract-based sustainable transport consultancy services to a variety of clients.
- 1.3 We are now looking for an experienced individual to launch and manage Transform's consultancy arm.

2 Job Description

- 2.1 Prepare and implement launch of 'transform research and communications'.
- 2.2 Lead on the development of 'transform research and communications' marketing materials.
- 2.3 Identify and manage a pool of specialist, independent consultants (associates).
- 2.4 Identify, negotiate, attract and manage contracts from fee-paying clients within the sustainable transport sector.
- 2.5 Where appropriate, depending on skill set, contribute to delivery of contract work.
- 2.6 Implement the 'transform research and communications' marketing strategy, attend relevant events, and identify other opportunities to promote the business.
- 2.7 Ongoing monitoring and evaluation of progress against agreed targets as per the consultancy Business Plan.
- 2.8 Work in collaboration with Transform Scotland Director and other staff.

Essential

- 3.1 Proven skills in winning business, identifying appropriate business opportunities and generating income.
- 3.2 Proven skills in project management, management of contracts and verification of other consultants' work.
- 3.3 Excellent written and verbal communication skills including report writing and client liaison.
- 3.4 Attention to detail and the ability to deliver contracts on time and to budget.
- 3.5 A client-focused approach, excellent inter-personal skills and the ability to form collaborative partnerships.

3.6 Experience of working with consultants and delegating technical aspects of contracts to specialist consultants.

Desirable

- 3.7 Experience of the sustainable transport sector.
- 3.8 Experience of social enterprise (business) development.
