What we do

We help private, public and third sector organisations to build support for sustainable transport in Scotland. We provide advice to improve services and facilities, promote greener ways to travel, and help to secure investment and support for the sustainable transport industry.

Our work includes:

Research, monitoring and evaluation

Campaigns and communications

We design, plan and run publicity and awareness-raising campaigns to promote sustainable transport. We are experts in social media, online campaigns, media strategy and working with the Scottish press.

Transport strategy

We research and write action plans and strategies for cycling, walking, bus, train, light rail and ferry use.

Government and public affairs
